Finca Antigua Blanco DO, La Mancha, Spain, grape variety: Viura

In 1889, Joaquín Martínez Bujanda founded the winery that still bears his name today. Today the Familia owns vineyards in the Rioja, Rueda and La Mancha. The hallmark of the finca is the unusual approach to the selection of the grapes for the individual wines, because each parcel is intended for the production of a different wine. Finca Blanco has fresh aromas of citrus, peach, pear and subtle floral notes. Very fresh and aromatic on the palate with a long finish.

Finca Antigua Tempranillo DO, La Mancha, Spain, Grape: Tempranillo

Tempranillo DO - In the fruity nose, cherries and elderberries as well as sweet cinnamon and vanilla; Soft tannins on the palate, lots of red fruit, typical Tempranillo sweetness in a round body, cranberries and fading roses, even some mint, nice balance right up to the cherry-dominated finale.

Malanser Pinot Noir AOC, Von Salis, Grison Swiss

The Bündner Herrschaft has borne its name since the 16th century, when the "Three Leagues" bought up the area. Red wines, which today account for by far the largest share of production, were only introduced in the 17th century. Today, there are over 40 grape varieties on around 420 hectares in the Herrschaft, which are cultivated by around 90 winegrowing businesses. The ingredients for success are the not too lush, permeable and ideal climate in the Grisons Rhine Valley, which is characterized by plenty of sunshine, the Föhn wind and the enormously important, large temperature differences between day and night. This Pinot Noir is fresh, elegantly flowing, aromas of ripe wild berries and Hagenbutten, very supple.

Something special!

Bin 407 Cabernet Sauvignon, Penfolds, Australia

The Penfolds Bin 407 does not open up immediately, but then releases the typical Cabernet aromas of ripe blackcurrants, mulberries, blueberries before notes of heather and tomato (leaves). On the palate, the 407 is clearly focussed, ripe and full-bodied, fleshy, juicy with slightly sweet and earthy-spicy notes (fresh beetroot), notes of preserved black cherries with a hint of peppermint, the tannin is vividly present, but powdery-gently matured, the new oak (one third after all!), long finish. For Penfolds Bin 407, the Cabernet Sauvignon is fermented traditionally and the wine is aged for twelve months in new French oak barrels (27%) and American oak barrels (7%), as well as in American oak barrels from multiple occupancy (66%).

Open Wine Rose

Eau de Provence Rosé, Private Wine Collection, MDCV Château et Vignobles, France

France Character: Pale shimmering pink with copper reflections in the glass. A beguiling summer bouquet of citrus peel and red berries, complemented by delicately spicy notes of Provençal herbs, a hint of cinnamon and wild pine. On the palate, there are flavours of vineyard peach, juicy apricot and grapefruit. A fresh, creamy rosé full of tension and fruit complexity. True to its name - Eau de Provence! Terroir: The 150 hectares of vineyards are located on a chalk plateau at 300 metres above sea level. The cool nights and high daytime temperatures allow the grapes to ripen for a long time, giving them depth of character and fresh flavours. The well-drained subsoil provides a constant supply of water and gives the wine an elegant minerality. Grape variety: Cinsault, Syrah.

Prosecco was once the name of a grape variety that winemakers all over Italy pressed. But since 2009 the Prosecco grape is no longer called Prosecco, but "Glera" and the term Prosecco is a protected designation of origin. There are two quality levels:

D.O.C. means Denominazione di Origine Controllata. D.O.C.G. stands for Denominazione di Origine Controllata e Garantita. Grape variety: Glera (formerly Prosecco)

Petite Arvine Aphrodine AOC, Albert Mathier, Valais



The Mathier family, now well known, immigrated to Salgesch in the Valais from Marseille in the 14th century. During the world economic crisis, in the 1920s, he tried to defy the recession and planted vines on various slopes. In this way, Albert Mathier laid the foundation stone for the Mathiers' wine history in Switzerland. Aphrodine presents itself with an intense bouquet reminiscent of exotic fruits, such as pineapple and lime. Taste: full-bodied, refreshing and lively with mineral flavours and grapefruit aromas. Two essential components define the tasting: salt and grapefruit, which make the wine an exceptional pleasure.

Temperature-controlled fermentation at 18°C. Aging on the fine lees for 6 months without malolactic fermentation (MAD). No fining agents of animal origin were used for the expansion, which is why the Salis BIO-logical line is also 100% vegan.

Pinot Grigio DOC, Kellerei Kurtatsch, South Tyrol

Lagrein DOC, Kellerei Kurtatsch, Alto Adige

The Kurtatsch winery is located on the South Tyrolean Wine Route, 30 minutes south of Bolzano. The main source of income for the inhabitants of Kurtatsch is wine and fruit growing. Le Cupole Rosso Toscana DOCG, Tenuta di Trinoro

The Tenuta di Trinoro of cult winemaker Andrea Franchetti, located in a godforsaken part of Tuscany south of the Brunello region, has quickly become a myth. Wine lovers from all over the world go into raptures when they hear this name. In the Val d'Orcia near the border to Umbria and Lazio, the scion of the Cinzano empire and nephew of the famous American painter Cy Twombly, who is considered somewhat eccentric, conceives and develops some very extraordinary red wines - "Le Cupole" is certainly one of them. Grape variety: 58% Cabernet Franc, 32% Merlot, 6% Cabernet Sauvignon, 4% Petit Verdot

Sasso Bucato IGT, Azienda Agricola Russo, Toscana - Maremma

Azienda Agricola Russo is a purely family-run winery and is located on the Podere Metocchina, in a hilly suburb of the municipality of Suvereto. The Azienda Russo has only been bottling its own wines since 1998, but the roots of the winery are rooted in a long family tradition. The winery is always bustling with activity. Cured meats, cheese and bread, fruit, vegetables and cereals are grown. But above all, the Azienda Russo is also known for the cultivation of olives on over five hectares with about 1600 trees.

Although Giacomo Neri's wines have been among the best from Montalcino or even from all of Italy for years, he has never been much in the limelight and was little known, especially abroad. This changed abruptly at the turn of the year 2006/2007, when first his Tenuta Nuova 2001 was placed first in the top 100 world ranking list by the "Wine Spectator" and then in January 2007 the Cerretalto 2001 even received the dream mark of 100 points. Three different Brunellos are produced: The basic Brunello comes from the traditional vineyards around the cellar and is also pressed and vinified according to tradition.

Château de Gironville, Haut Médoc AOC, Bordeaux

Character Château de Gironville 2016 is a composition of elegant Cabernet Sauvignon. Numerous tasting comparisons prove that Château Gironville outshines many of the well-known Haut-Médoc thanks to its low yields and careful vinification. Château de Gironville 2016 is real proof that a good Bordeaux does not have to be expensive or elitist. *Terroir* The balanced climate and the quality of the soil produce fully ripe grapes. These essential factors provide the five-hectare vineyard in the commune of Macau in the Haut-Médoc with a solid foundation for a good result. *Grape variety:* Cabernet Sauvignon

Château de Pitray, Côte de Castillon AOC, Bordeaux

*Probably the most famous wine region in the world: Bordeaux. Unique terroir - great history. Everything comes together here, be it the perfect climate, the exceptional soils or the incredible winemaking tradition with an enormous wealth of experience and knowledge. This makes Bordeaux undeniably one of the absolute top wine regions in the world. The Atlantic climate with humid, mild winters, rainy springs and dry, hot summers and early autumns creates the perfect conditions for the typical Bordeaux grape varieties grown here. They also benefit from excellent soils, which are characterised by deep gravel, sand, clay or graves, depending on the location. Bordeaux's 112,000 hectares of vineyards are divided into around 50 areas of origin, known as appellations. These are generally divided into left-bank and right-bank areas: Médoc, Graves and Sauternes are the most important left-bank areas (left bank of the Gironde and Garonne), St. Émilion and Pomerol are the most important on the right bank (of the Dordogne river). Different varieties are cultivated, mostly for decades. The most widely cultivated red grape varieties in the Bordeaux region are Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot. The white grape varieties are dominated by Sémillon, Sauvignon Blanc and Muscadelle. So it is hardly surprising that the wines from Bordeaux have been among the best in the world for years. *Grape variety:* Merlot & Cabernet Sauvignon & Cabernet Franc*

Decero Syrah, Bodegas Finca Decero, Mendoza

*The Syrah vines at Finca Decero grow on soils rich in clay. The vineyards are located at an altitude of 1050 metres above sea level. The cool nights help to preserve the natural acidity and freshness of the aromas. The Decero Syrah shows fleshy flavours, fig and mineral notes. The structure of the wine is reminiscent of Syrah from the north of the Rhône. The tannins are open but not grippy and the wine has a long fruity finish. Finca Decero, once a barren patch of land in the Argentinian foothills of the Andes, is now a single vineyard. *Grape variety:* Syrah*

Puro Malbec, Ojo de Vino, Aqua, Dieter Meier, Mendoza

*Agrelo Alto, Mendoza. In 1997, artist and "Yello" star Dieter Meier decided to emigrate part-time to Argentina. He bought 2,200 hectares of land in the Argentinian pampas and founded his organic farm and vineyard called Ojo de Agua. Today, his PURO wines are a cult favourite. A young, fruit-intensive Malbec with a dense violet-red colour. Notes of cooked fruit, herbs such as thyme and mint and subtle hints of ground stone on the nose. Soft and full-bodied on the palate, very nice, juicy Malbec fruitiness that lingers for a long time, beautiful, soft tannins give the wine the necessary structure. Malbec at its best! *Grape variety:* Malbec*

Carmelo Rodero Reserva, Bodegas Rodero, Ribera del Duero DO

Very balanced with an attractive and intense deep cherry colour with light violet reflections and an amber rim. Particularly subtle nose with ripe fruit flavours, combined with roasted and spicy notes (vanilla and cinnamon) and hints of coffee. Surprisingly fleshy with a perfectly balanced acidity and a lingering finish. Round with ripe, elegant tannins and an extremely pleasant mouthfeel. Grape variety: Tempranillo, Cabernet Sauvignon

Carmelo Rodero Pago de Valtorreña, Bodegas Rodero, Ribera del Duero DO

One of the best Tempranillo in the world. The flagship from Rodero! Tempranillo from a privileged single vineyard. The grapes of the Tinta del País (Tempranillo) variety come from the single vineyard "Valtorrena", the vines are 45 to 55 years old. A dense, viscous wine red in the glass with purple reflections, the nose reveals aromas of blackberries, black cherries, cassis, blueberries, liquorice and bread bark, the palate is full-bodied with beautifully integrated tannins. The wine is aged for 24 months in French barriques. Grape variety: Tempranillo

Mauro Tinto Cosecha DO, Bodegas Mauro, Castilla y León

Bodegas Mauro is the project of the legendary Castilian winemaker Mariano García and his sons Alberto and Eduardo. The winery and the majority of the 80 vineyards they own are located just a few kilometres west of the DO Ribera del Duero border. The wines are made from Tempranillo, although the entry-level wine Mauro has had 10% Syrah in the cuvée for several years. While Mauro hardly ever comes into contact with new wood, the selection wine Vendimia Seleccionada matures only in new oak. Mauro is undoubtedly one of the greatest Tempranillos in the world. Dark chocolate, plums, cinnamon cherries and dried bananas on the nose; powerful on the palate with soft tannins and a fleshy body, well-balanced, with clear cherry flavours on the finish. Château Mouton Rothschild received its current name after it was acquired in 1853 by Baron Nathaniel de Rothschild from the English branch of the famous dynasty. For a long time, despite the increasingly recognised quality of its wine, Mouton hardly aroused the interest of its owners, who were unwilling to travel to what was then a disadvantaged region. It was therefore a good day when Baron Philippe de Rothschild, in 1922 at the age of 20, took over the reins of a winery to which he was to devote his life.

The wine-growing area of the DO Pessac-Léognan designation of origin is of French origin, a sub-region of the Graves and located south of the city of Bordeaux, being home to the towns of Pessac Léognan, Mériignac, Talence and Grézillac.

The grape varieties used for white wine production in this region are the Sémillon and the Sauvignon. As far as red wine production is concerned, the grapes used are mainly Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot. The red wines of this region are characterised by their notes of red berries, ripe fruit and cocoa, while the white wines are reminiscent of orange sticks, wood and passion fruit.
